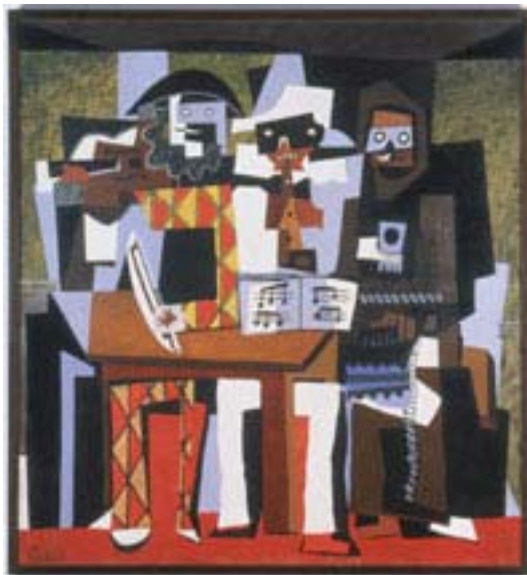


## **SAVE THE DATE!**
